

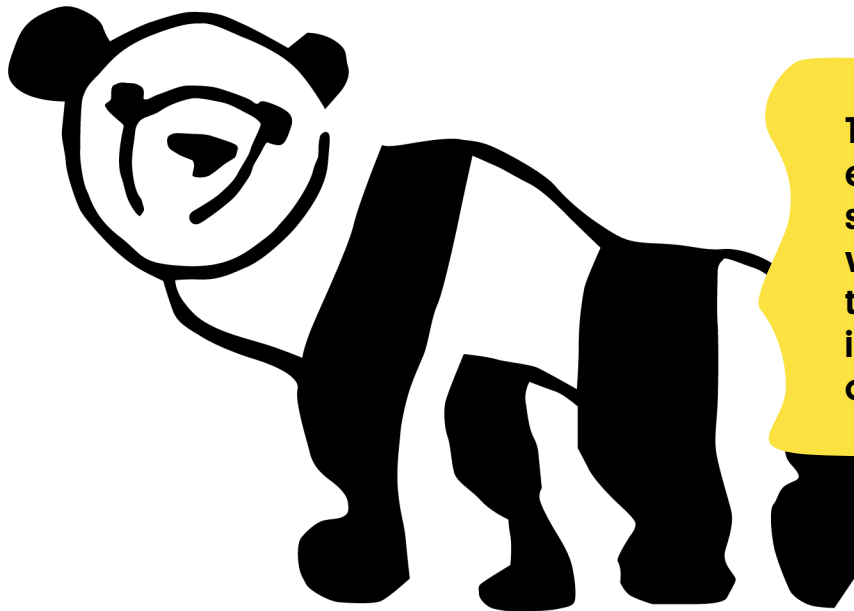



HOW TO PRINT A PANDA



BOBBINHOOD PRESENTS A SUPER EASY STEP BY STEP MANUAL.



1  **SCALE**
the design to your preferred size.

5  **CLEAN**
and dry your screen, squeegee and template thoroughly after every layer. (You can use our stencil paper over and over again. Clean carefully and dry flat).

2  **TRACE**
the design on stencil paper. For this design you need 1 sheet of stencil paper, one for each layer/color.

6  **SET**
the ink according to the instructions on your container

3  **CUT**
out the 1 stencil. 

4  **PRINT LAYERS**
