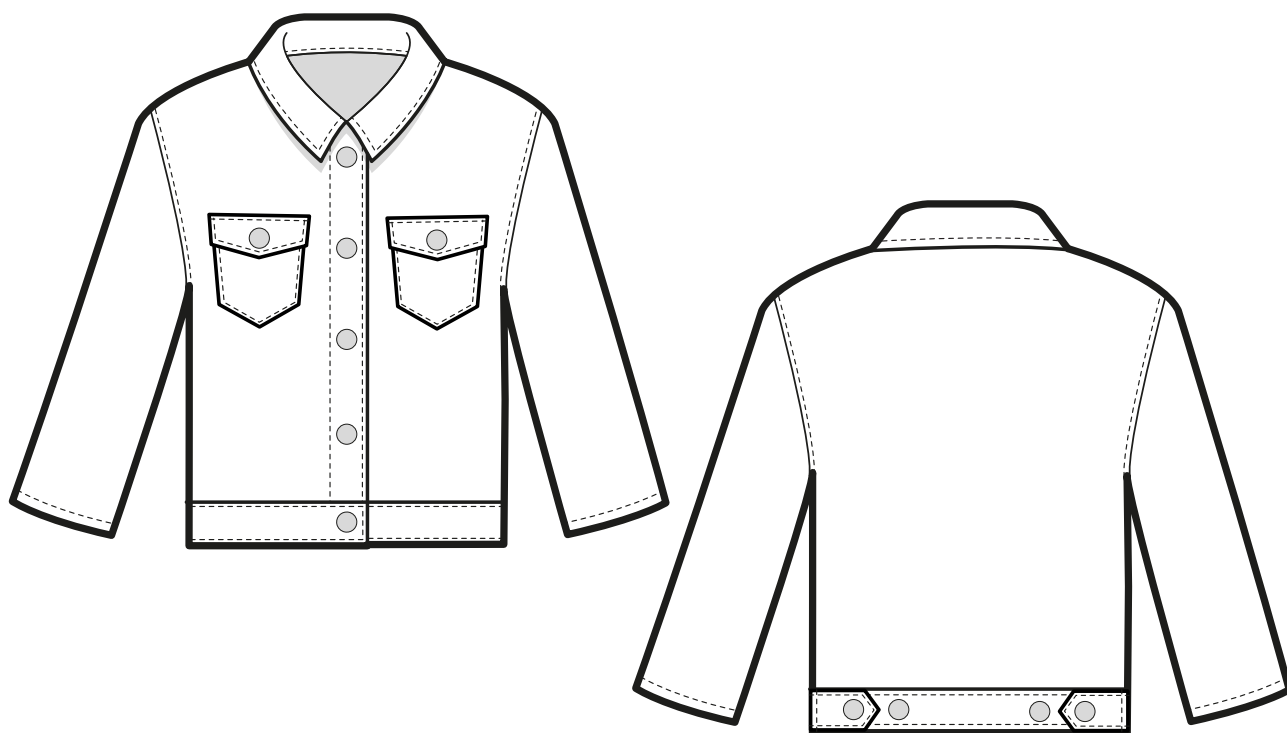

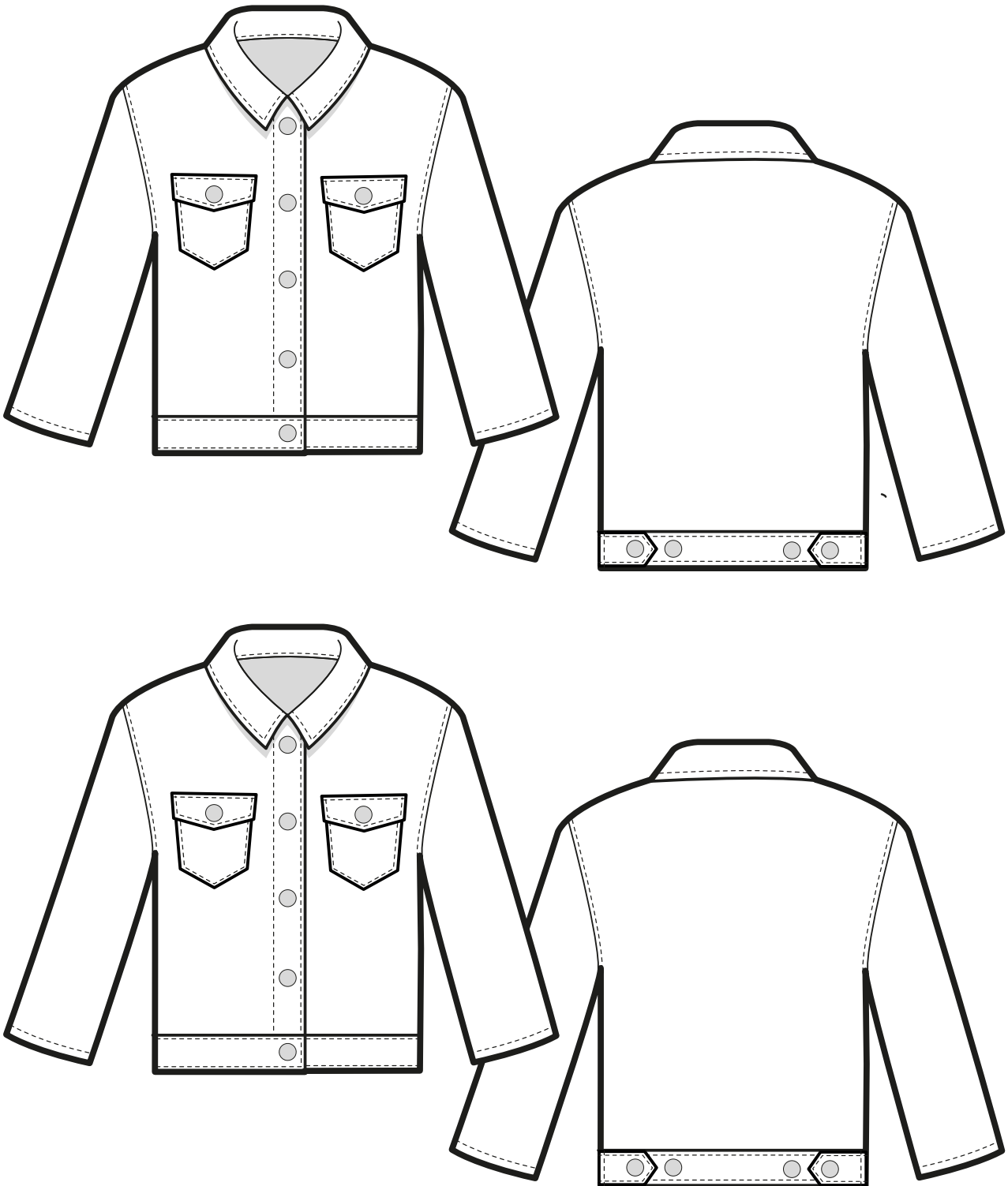


**With this manual you can turn your Bobbinhood suit pattern into this awesome jacket. Use a denim, twill, (faux) leather, all is good!**

# 1st THINGS 1st

- 1** This pattern is **WITHOUT** seam allowance. We like to add 1 cm - 3/8" but please add what you are you used to. Add this allowance to all seams.
- 2** You will need the Bobbinhood suit pattern and manual as well as this hack manual to be able to make this jacket.
- 3** Pre wash your fabric and iron before cutting. No fun at all if you ask me but veeeery important ;)
- 4** Have fun! This manual is just a guideline, please feel free to do whatever you feel like.

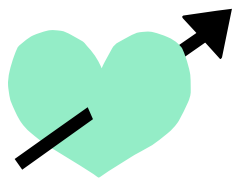
## fabric requirements

For this hack we recommend a fabric with a bit of body. Medium, or even heavy denim, sturdy linnen, twill, (faux) leather etc etc.

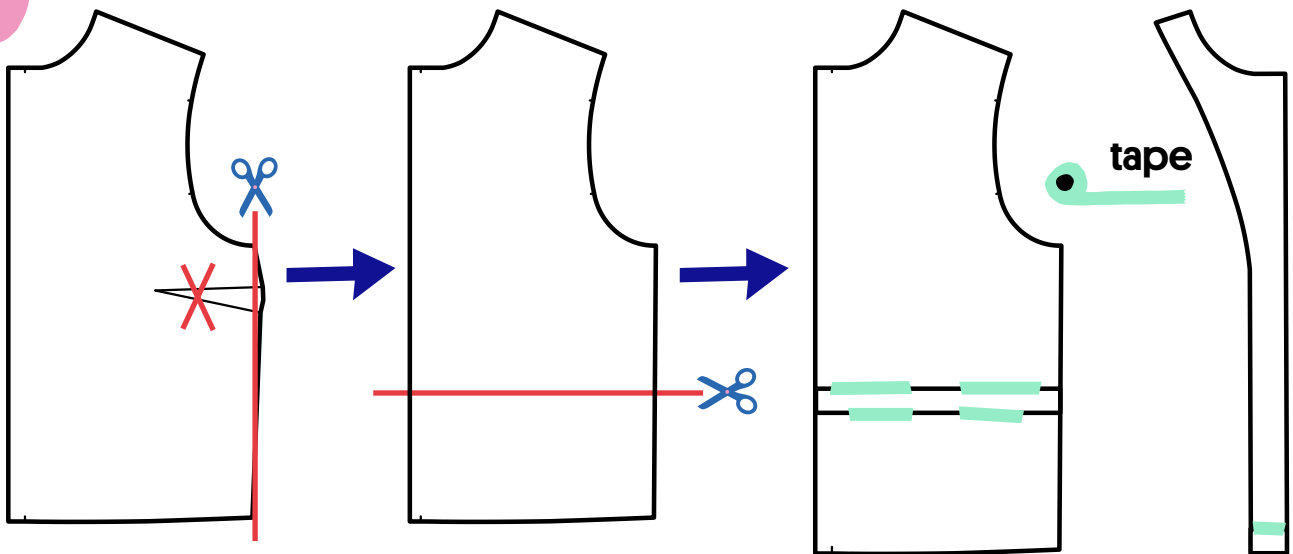
# HACK PATTERNS

**1**

For this pattern hack use the patterns A to F of the Bobbinhood Suit Pattern. Add the 3 patterns you printed out on the previous pages: G1, G2 and X.

**2**

Adjust front pattern.



Ignore the bust dart. Make side seam straight.

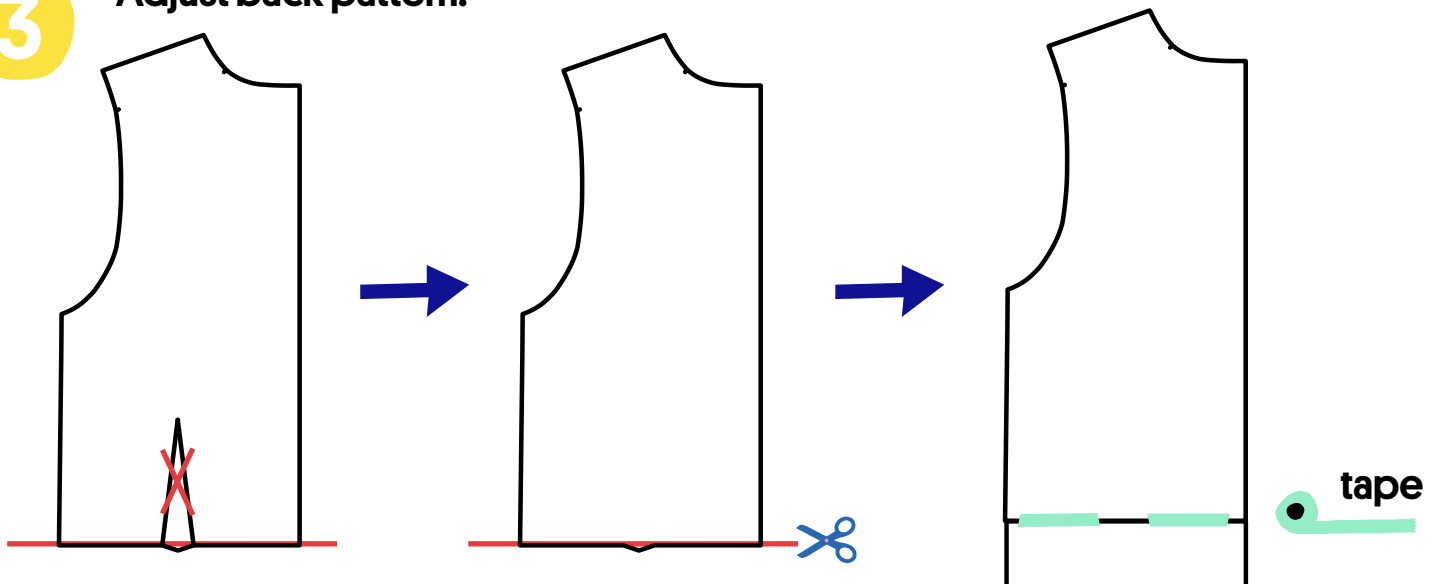
Cut through pattern, horizontal.

Lengthen the pattern with 2,5 cm-1"

Adjust facing to the same length.

**3**

Adjust back pattern.



Ignore the bust dart.

Make seam straight.

Lengthen the pattern with 5cm-2"

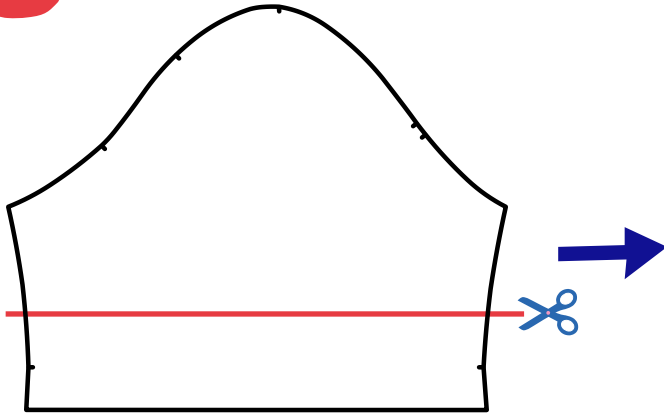




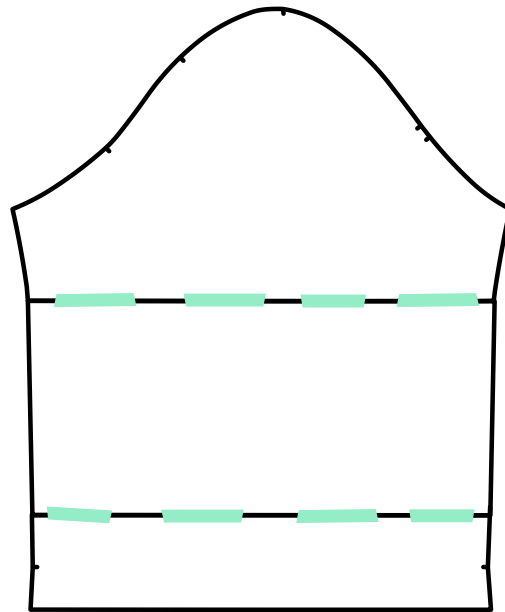

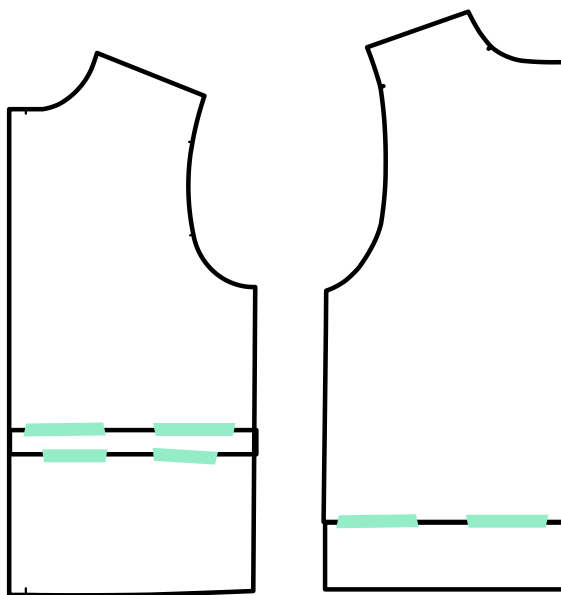

Draw the waistband pattern.

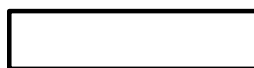
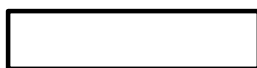
The pattern is 9cm- 3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" high for all sizes.



Measure the lower seam of  
both the front pattern and  
back pattern. Draw the front  
and back waistbands just as  
wide and 9cm-3<sup>6</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" high.  
Tape them together at the  
side seam.

That the back waistband has  
to be placed on the fold.  
Remember that all patterns  
are without seam allowance.  
So also this one!

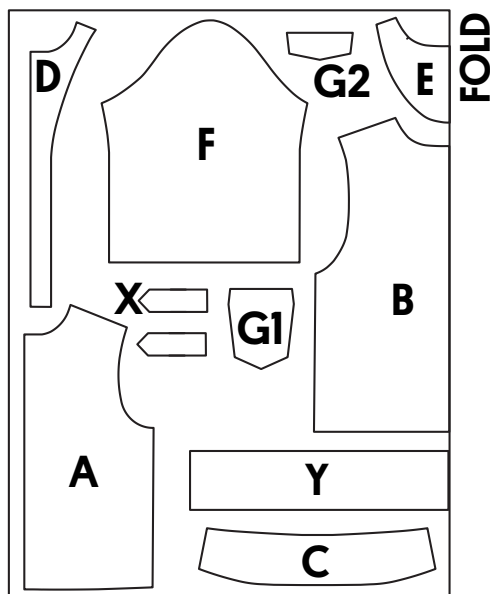

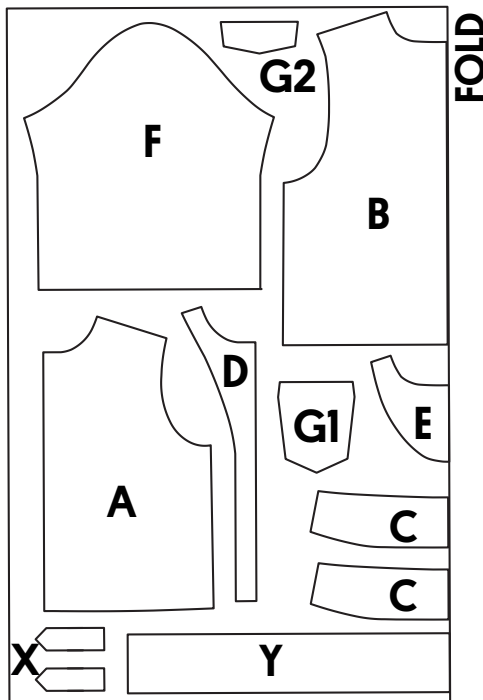

Fabric width 150cm - 60"

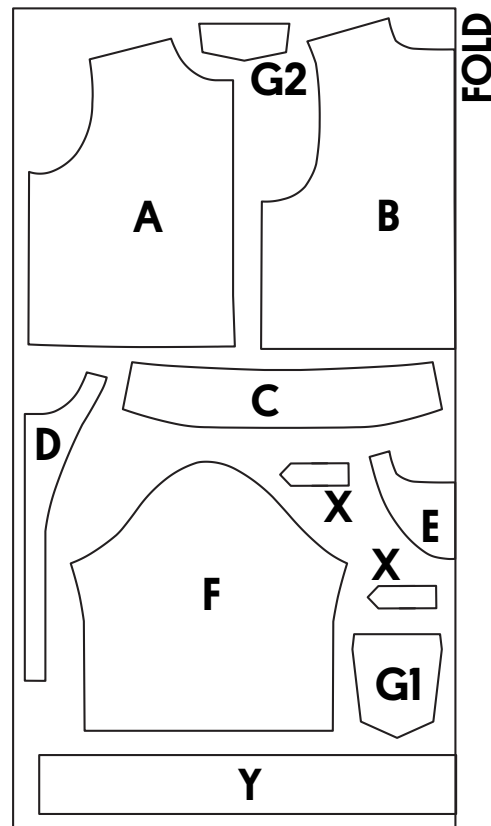

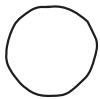
- It is also possible to place the collar with CB on the foldline x2, like we did here for size XL.

- A. Front top  
2x fabric
- B. Back top  
1x fabric, fold
- C. Collar  
2x fabric, 1x fusing
- D. Facing front  
2x fabric, 2x facing
- E. Facing back  
1x fabric, fold
- F. Sleeve  
2x fabric
- G1. Front pocket  
2x fabric
- G2. Front flap pocket  
4x fabric, 2x fusing
- X. Side strap  
4x fabric, 2x fusing
- Y. Waistband  
1x fabric, fold



# WORK FLOW

Here at Bobbinhood we have a thing for creative workflow charts. For every project we do we make a clear list of steps and whenever we worked on a step we grab our markers and color the indicators. It's so fun we decided to make you one for this project as well!



**Measure yourself**



**Print new pockets and straps**



**Hack the pattern.**



**Make a muslin (or not if your like to wing it :))**



**Cut everything**



**Fuse**



**Sew pockets and flaps**



**Make jacket**



**Sew on waistband and straps**



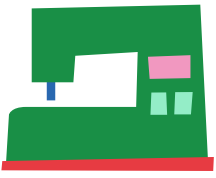
**Attach buttons**

# LET'S GO

For this hack you'll need your Bobbinhood manual at hand as well and you will switch back and forth. You will only need the TOP PART section that starts on page 11. We will talk you through the entire hack. No worries!

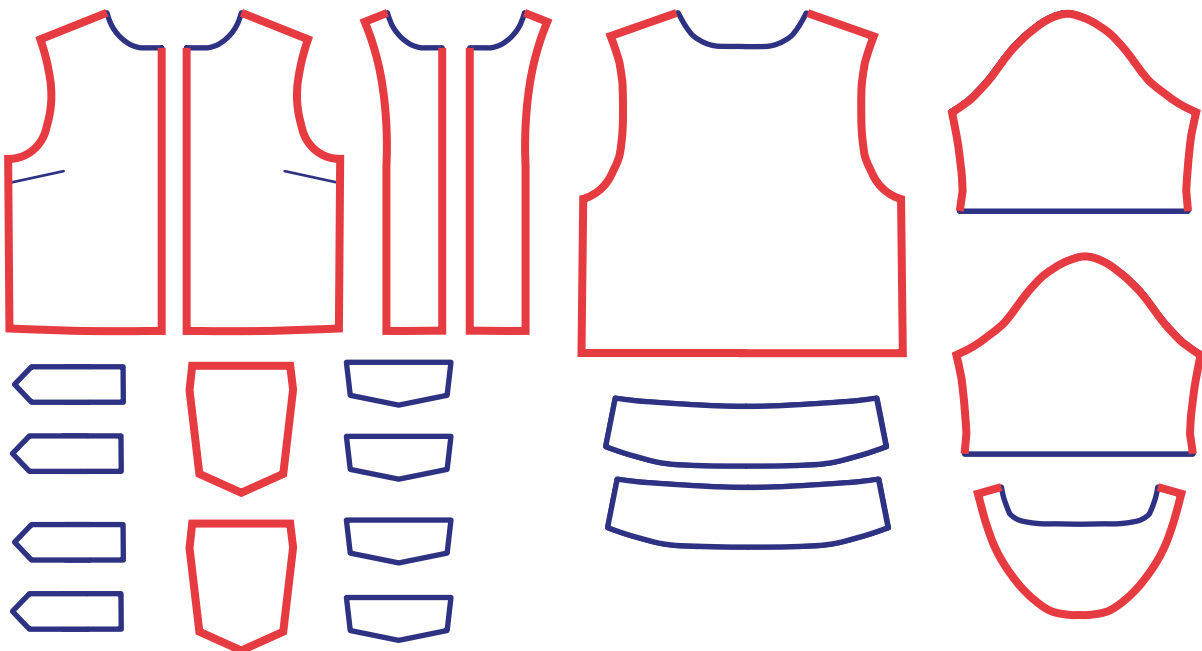


Seam that has to be stitched in that step



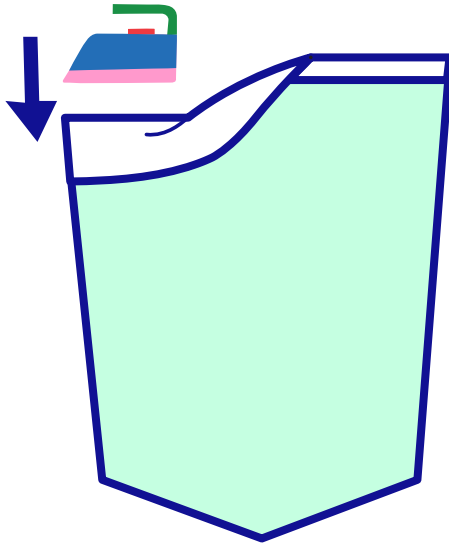
Seam that has to be finished

Skip **1** and **2** of the Bobbinhood Suit manual and go straight to finishing your seams. Finish all seams that are indicated red, we recommend using a serger.



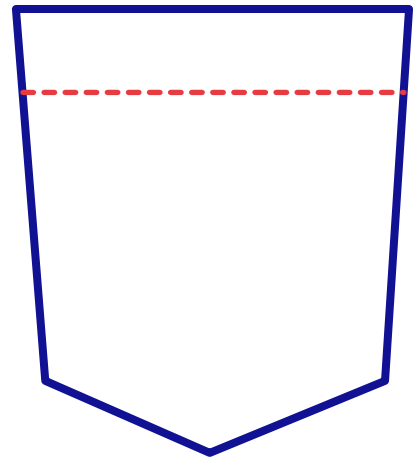
For this pattern hack we have changed the pockets so ignore step **4** to **7** and replace them with the following:

 Fold down 1 cm - 3/8", press. Then fold down 2,5 cm - 1". Press.



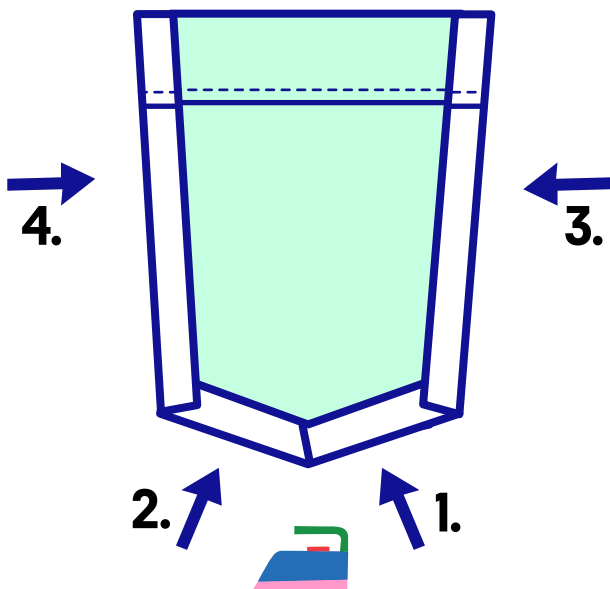
Pattern on the fold (back)


 Top stitch at 2,3 cm - 7/8".

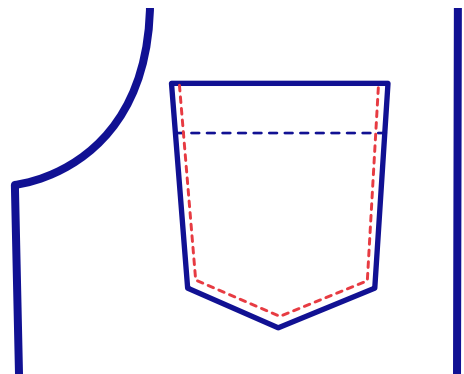


Pattern to cut x2 (front)

 Fold the sides and bottom in 1 cm - 3/8". Press.



 Place top of the pocket according to the Bobbinhood suit pattern. Single or double stitch (whatever suits your style) the pocket. Zigzag the top for more strength.

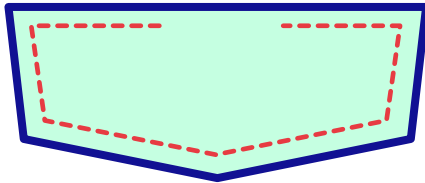




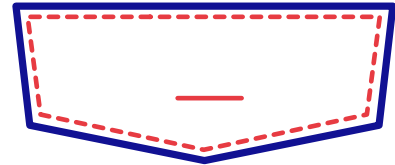
**Stitch the pocket flaps together.**

 **Cut the edges and trim the seams.**

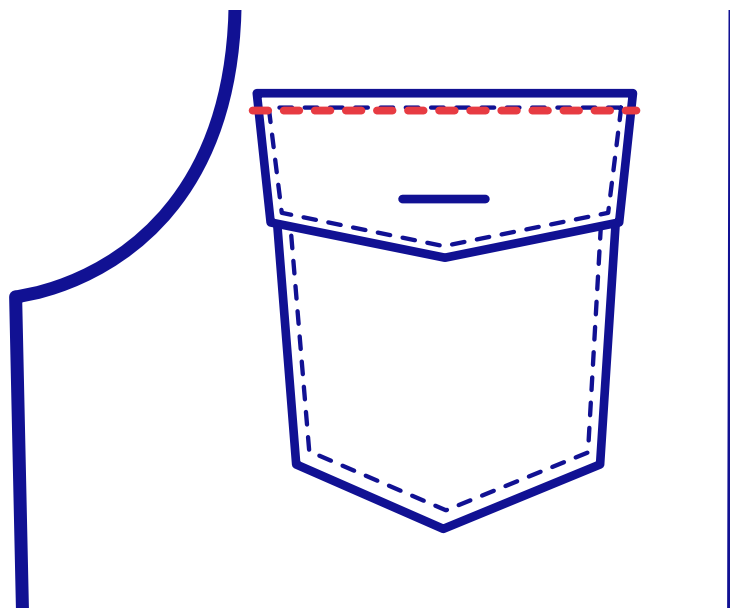
**Leave open to turn.**



**Top stitch the pocket flaps and make a buttonhole that fits your button or if you want to use a snapbutton, put in the top part..**



**Place the flap of the pocket about 1,5cm - 5/8" above the pocket and topstitch.**

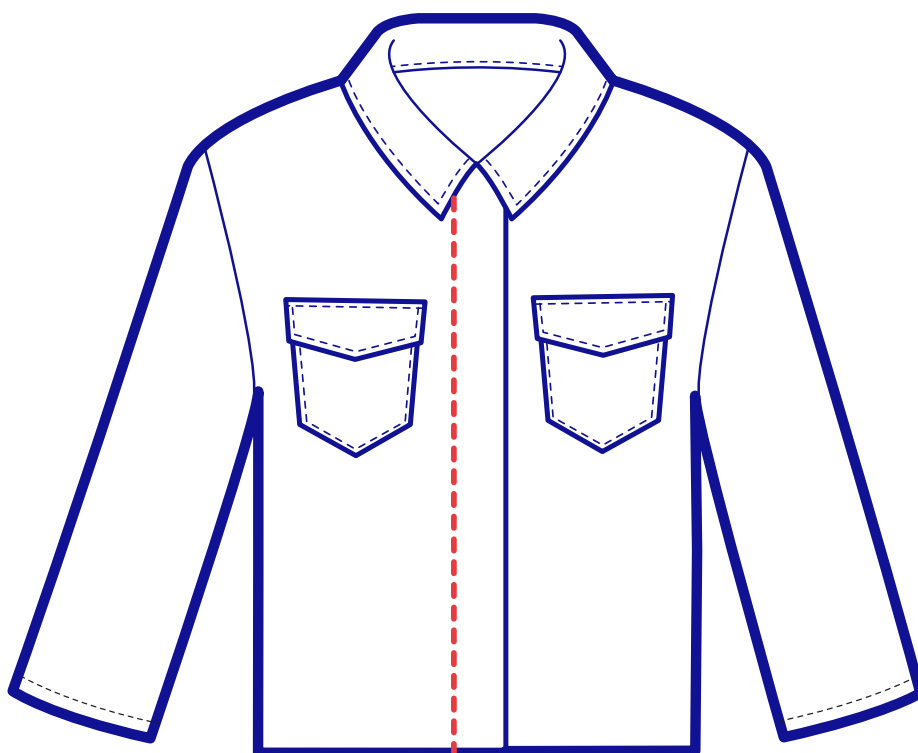


Follow step 8 to 19 of the Bobbinhood Suit manual.  
At 19 we stitch the hem of our sleeve. You can also choose for a 'rough' finish of the sleeve hem like our accomplice Marleen did. Just cut of the hem at the notches and stitch around twice at about 0,5cm- 1/4".



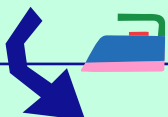
Top stitch both front facings.

You can follow the facing or simply go straight up whatever you feel like ❤️



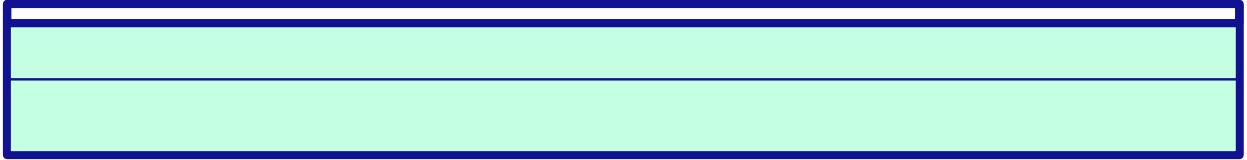
Continue with the waistband.

Press the belt wrong sides of the waistband together.



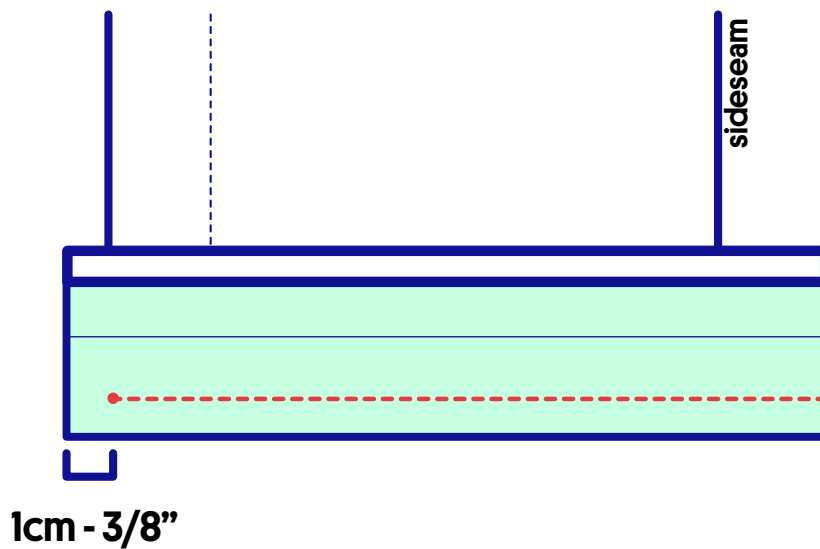


Then press the top 1 cm-3/8”.

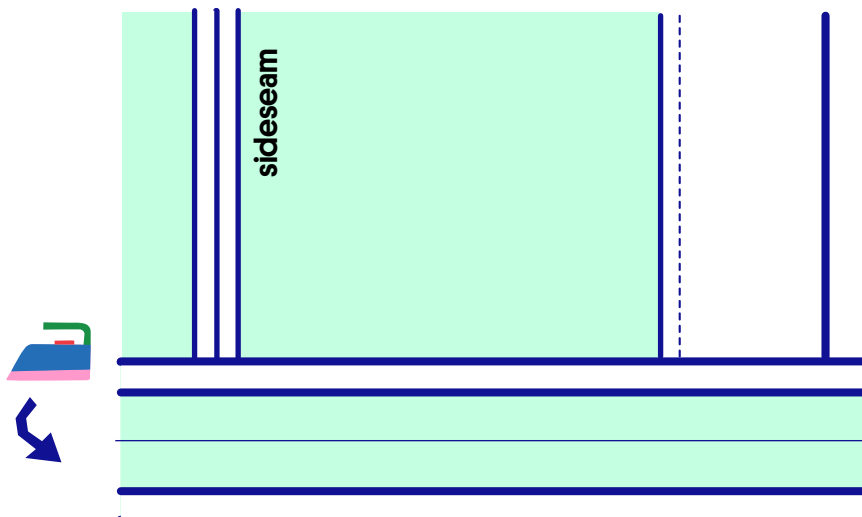


Place the waistband right side on right side and pin it 1cm-5/8” over the front on both sides.

Stitch from front to front. Do not stitch the first and last cm as indicated.



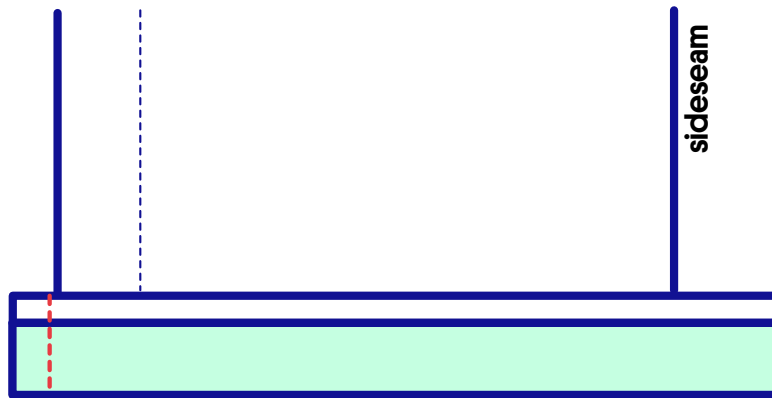
On the inside of the jacket iron the seam you just stitched down.







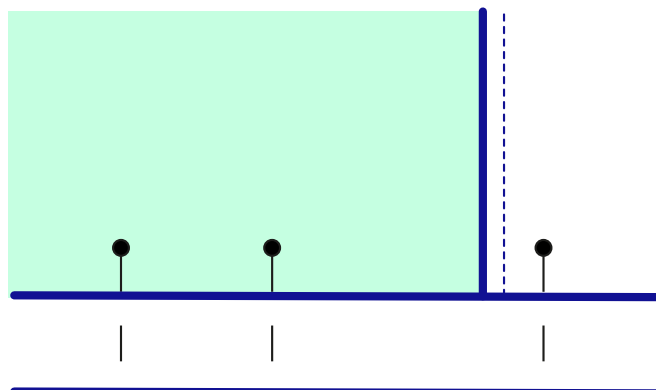
**Fold the waistband up, right side on right side and stitch the two front seams.**



**Trim corner.**



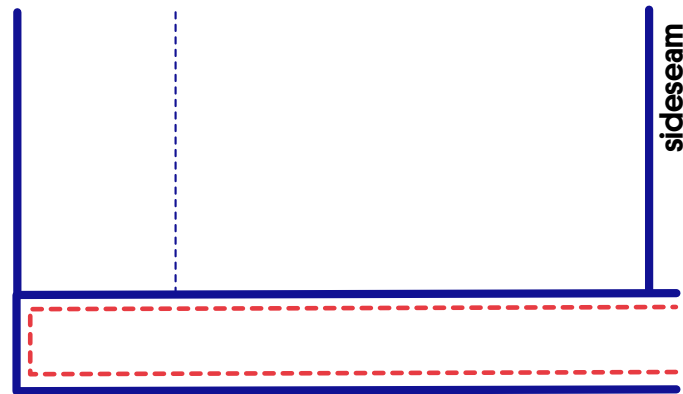
**Turn waistband to the right side. Press and pin.**



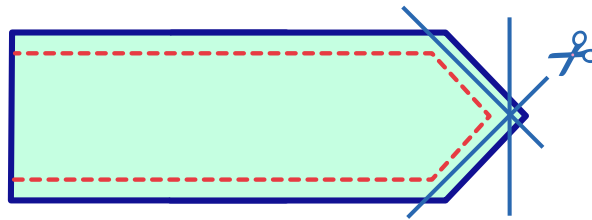
**Or..... use double sided adhesive tape made for sewing!**



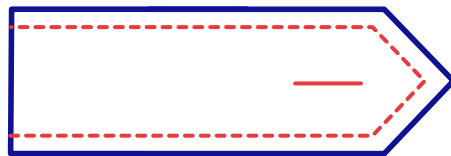
**Top stitch waistband aaaalllll around!**



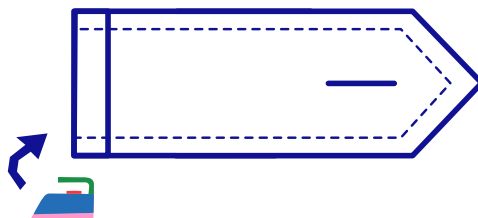
**Pin strap right side to right side and stitch around leaving the straight end open. Trim corners.**



**Turn and press. Top stitch and make a buttonhole that fits your button or if you want to use a snapbutton, put in the top part.**

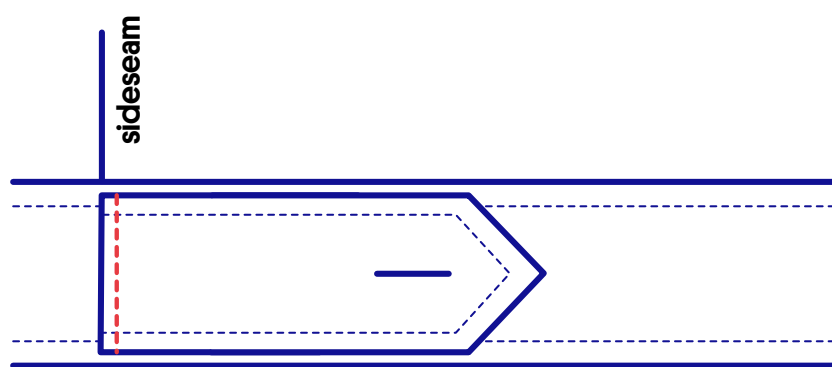


**Press the end 1cm-3/8" to the back.**

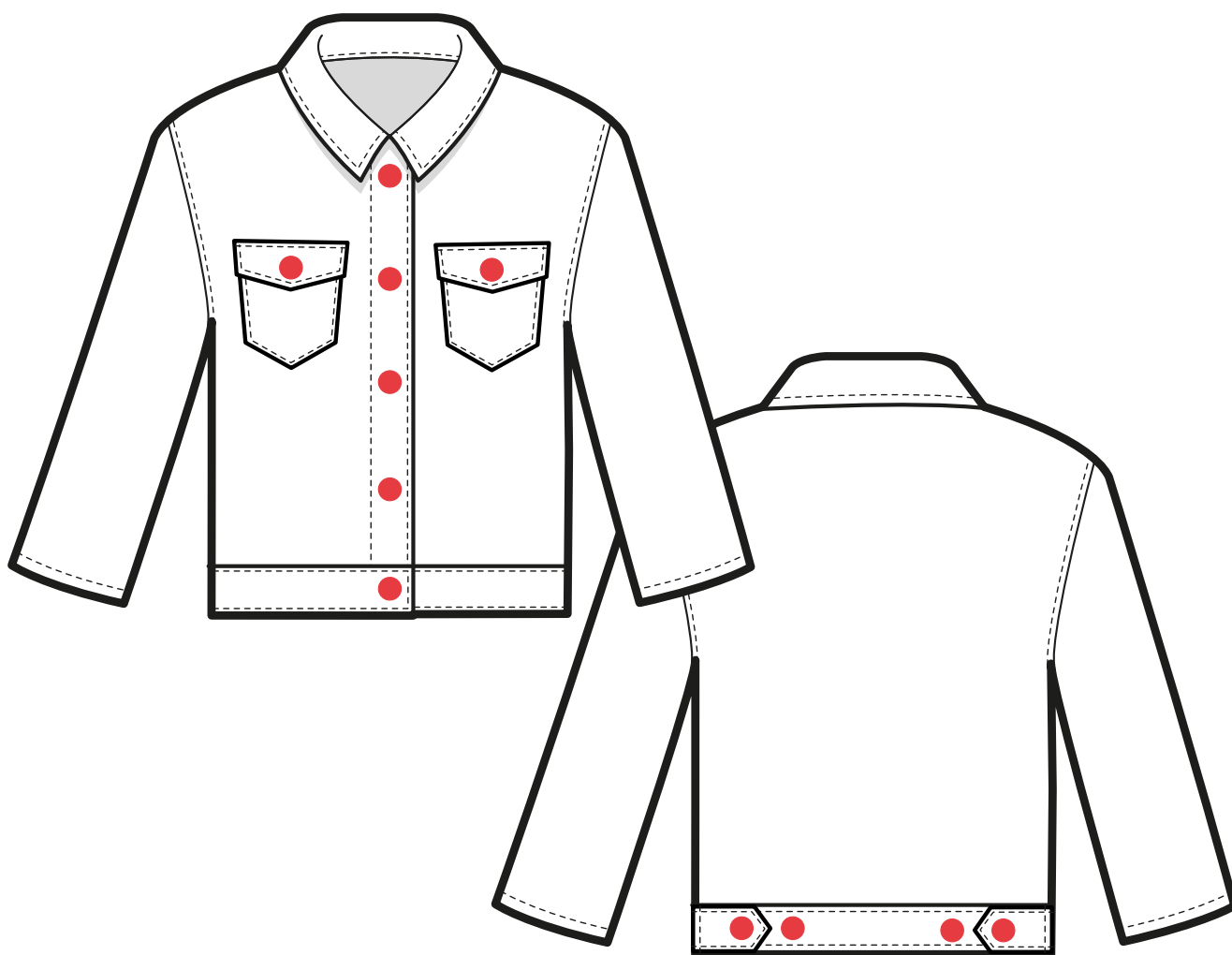




**Stitch sideflap on the back close to the side seam.**



**Attach all the (snap)buttons.**



**Let's celebrate!!! Now you can strut around in your new Bobbinhood Jacket!
